Melanie Morgan

Every morning, Melanie Morgan co-hosts a top-rated drive-time show in one of the largest radio markets in the nation: The Lee Rodgers and Melanie Morgan Show on KSFO 560AM, San Francisco. Morgan is Chairman of Move America Forward, an organization dedicated to supporting our troops in their fight against terrorism.

A broadcast journalist with over 30 years experience, Morgan won The Associated Press Mark Twain Award for Best Special Program "Voices of Soldiers" Live from Iraq, 2005 and is a weekly columnist for *WorldNetDaily*. Morgan has also won awards for her coverage of the 1983 bombing of the Marine barracks in Beirut, Lebanon, the uprising for Democracy at Tiananmen Square in China, and the earthquake that rocked Mexico City in 1988.

A frequent guest on Fox News Channel, CNN, MSNBC, NBC, ABC, and CBS, Morgan has also appeared on the BBC and in newspapers and broadcasts worldwide. She lives in Marin County, California.

Catherine Moy

Catherine Moy is an award-winning journalist honored by prestigious media groups for her works as an investigative reporter, feature writer, columnist, political journalist, business writer, and agricultural reporter; winning the Society of Professional Journalists highest award for public service. She is also a Pulitzer nominee.

Her 20 years of investigative work has led to changes in federal laws that help protect the elderly from abuse, and uncovered a large electric company's failure to notify people who were exposed to a cancer-causing agent after equipment exploded. Moy was among the first journalists to investigate the issues around illegal immigration.

Moy is a freelance journalist and a columnist for the *Vacaville Reporter*. She lives in Solano County, California, with her husband and daughter and a menagerie of animals.
