## AMERICA NEEDS REAGAN-CHRISTIAN PRESIDENT

The result of Republicans offering RINOs (Republicans In Name Only) for president will be for the Grand Old Party to lose its core values that made it great. The party has become so misguided in fact, that in 2002 the Wall Street Journal issued an internal memo saying the paper would no longer use the acronym GOP to refer to the Republican's once Grand Old Party, since polls showed increasing numbers of Americans did not know that the GOP was synonymous with the Republican Party!
